The Trend

Production of Natural Rubber (NR) in the country during February 2006 increased to 51,505 tonnes compared to 38,205 tonnes during February 2005 recorded a growth of 35 percent due to conducive weather conditions and higher price. The cumulative production of NR during the first eleven months of the financial year 2005-06 was 756,735 tonnes depicting a growth of 6.9% as compared to 708,115 tonnes during the corresponding period of the previous year. The production provisionally estimated for March'06 is 46,000 tonnes.

There was a decrease in consumption of NR during February'06 to 66,670 tonnes from 67,945 tonnes during January'06. The total consumption of NR by the rubber goods industry during April'05 to February'06 was 732,555 tonnes as compared to 691,095 tonnes achieved a growth of 6.0 percent during the same period last year. The growth in consumption in the auto tyre manufacturing sector during the first eleven months of the year 2005-06 was 9.2 percent as against 7.2 percent attained during the same period of the previous year, where as the growth in the non-tyre sector was 2.3 percent compared to 2.2 percent in the same period of the previous year. The consumption provisionally estimated for March'06 is 69,000 tonnes.

Import of NR during February'06 was 881 tonnes as against

6546 tonnes during February'05. The total import during the first eleven months of the year 2005-06 was 42,428 tonnes as against 64,943 tonnes during the corresponding period of the previous year. The export of NR during February'06 was 5850 tonnes compared to 1735 tonnes during February'05. The cumulative export of NR for the first eleven months of the year 2005-06 was 65,383 tonnes as against 43,792 tonnes during the same period of the previous year. Stock of NR at the end February'06 was 117,380 tonnes.

Production as well as consumption of Synthetic Rubber (SR) in the country decreased during February 2006. Production of SR decreased to 8015 tonnes during February'06 from 8305 tonnes during January'06. The total production of SR during April'05 to February'06 has increased to 88,814 tonnes over the production of 85,220 tonnes during the corresponding period of the last year recording 4.2 percent growth. Consumption of SR decreased to 19115 tonnes during February'06 from 20,060 tonnes during January'06. The cumulative consumption of SR during the first eleven months of the year 2005-06 was 216,035 tonnes as compared to 205,870 tonnes registering a growth of 4.9 percent. .

The trend in the prices of different grades of NR at Kottayam market for the period from April'05 to April'06 is given below.
