**THE TREND**

**P**roduction of Natural Rubber (NR) in the country during September 2010 increased to 77,500 tonnes compared to 74,300 tonnes during September 2009. The cumulative production during the first half of 2010-11 was 375,250 tonnes compared to 348,625 tonnes during the corresponding period of the previous year, registering a growth of 7.6%, due to favourable weather conditions. The production provisionally estimated for October'10 is 82,000 tonnes.

Consumption of NR by the rubber goods manufacturing industry in the country during September'10 was 80,500 tonnes as against 79,500 tonnes during August'10. The total consumption of NR during April'10 to September'10 was 469,050 tonnes compared to 456,365 tonnes during the same period last year, recording a growth of 2.8%. During the first six

months of the current year, the auto tyre manufacturing sector registered a growth of 4.5% compared to 5.8 % achieved during the same period of the previous year, whereas the non-tyre sector showed a slight positive growth of 0.1% as against a negative growth of 2% attained during the same period of the previous year. During this period the growth in production of truck and bus tyres was 5% and passenger car was 41%. The consumption provisionally estimated for October'10 is 81,500 tonnes.

Import of NR in the country during September'10 was 36,106 tonnes compared to 18,612 tonnes during September'09. The cumulative import of NR during the first half of 2010-11 was 114,576 tonnes as against 122,095 tonnes during the same period of the previous year. The country exported only 194 tonnes of NR during September'10 compared to 574 tonnes

during September'09. The total export of NR during April'10 to September'10 was 4,558 tonnes compared to 1,591 tonnes during the corresponding period of the previous year. Stock of NR at the end of September'10 was 229,135 tonnes.

Production of Synthetic Rubber (SR) during September'10 increased to 9,245 tonnes from 8,942 tonnes during August'10. The cumulative production of SR during April'10 to September'10 was 53,331 tonnes as against 52,988 tonnes during the same period of the previous year. Consumption of SR slightly increased to 34,480 tonnes during September'10 as against 34,220 tonnes during August'10. The total consumption of SR during the first half of the current financial year was 201,625 tonnes compared to 158,515 tonnes during the corresponding period of the previous year, recording a growth of 27.2%.
